## Large multi-residential building

(four stories or taller in height or with more than 20 dwelling units)



## Small multi-residential building

(less than four stories in height and has 20 or fewer dwelling units)



## Ground-oriented dwelling

(detached, semi-detached and duplexes, fourplexes, townhouses, rowhouses & some low profile multi-residential buildings)

## Select Permit (max 1)

Can be used for either your vehicle or a visitor's vehicle.

Only one vehicle can be activated and parked at a time.

## Standard Residential Parking Permit (max 3)

Can only be used for your vehicle.

## Visitor Permit (max 2)

Can only be used for a visitor's vehicle. Only valid within 150 metres of your address.

## Non-resident Landlord Permit (max 1)

Can only be used by the owner or manager of a rental unit for occasional use. Only valid within 150 metres of the address.

## Market Permit (max 1)

Can only be used for your vehicle. Only valid within 150 metres of your address.

**Note:** \*Not all addresses within a RPZ are eligible for a Residential Parking Permit. (e.g. 25% or more commercial frontage at ground level).

\*\*You only need a Residential Parking Permit if you live in a RPZ and want to park in a 'except by permit' zones or to overstay in time-restricted zones.
